- 1) Near the administration building, you will find a wooden sculpture scene called “Chaos in Camp”. How many Native Americans are there in the camp?
- 2) Find the Baltic Mill, what year was it built? (Hint: check out the front of the building)
- 3) How many stone steps are there leading from the Baltic Mill to the Performing Arts Stage?
- 4) Locate the Baltic Mill Performing Arts Stage. On each side, you will find metal statues of musicians. How many total musicians are there?
- 5) Near the Baltic Mill, you will find the Kishwaukee River and you may be surprised to find “children” playing in the water year round. How many children are playing in the water?
- 6) Near the stage, you will find a sculpture donated by Jack & Peggy Wolf. What two animals are featured?
- 7) Find the pedestrian swinging bridge; it is much fun to cross! What is the weight limit on the bridge?
Remember to take your selfie from the bridge!
- 8) Find the fishing pavilion sponsored by the Lions Club. What FIVE fish are featured on the “Attention Anglers” sign?
- 9) Find the Whispering Winds shelter. How many posts hold up the building?
- 10) The park has a disc golf course. Find hole 5. Who is the sponsor of that hole? (Hint: located near the large stone grill across the river from the Baltic Mill).
