



# Scavenger Hunt

**Take the driveway into the park to the turn-around at the end. There you will find a picnic shelter and playground. Start your scavenger hunt there.**

- 1) What sizeable natural structures border the edge of the turn-around?
- 2) How many grills are located in the area next to the picnic shelter?
- 3) Where is the insect shown located in the park? Be specific.
- 4) What is this a close-up view a picture of?
- 5) What vintage piece of park equipment is this a picture of?
- 6) What is the purpose of this cement structure?
- 7) How many total steps are in this staircase? Where does it lead?



**Either drive or walk back towards the entrance OR take the trail to the left from the staircase. The trail crosses the driveway at the park entrance.**

- 8) Find the informational display at the park entrance (pictured). What FOUR kinds of trees are most prevalent in this park?
- 9) Cross the rust-colored bridge (pictured). How many boards make up the visible portion of the bridge floor?
- 10) Just over the bridge is a limestone cliff that hovers over Spring Brook Creek. What surprises you about this cliff?
