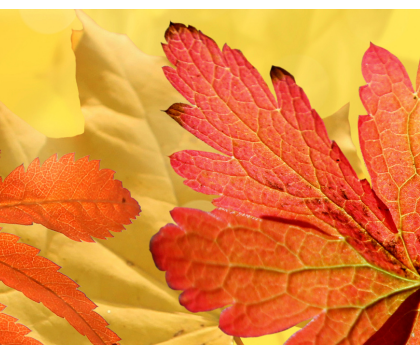




# 4-H LIBRARY PROGRAMS FOR YOUTH!

Check out the choices below!



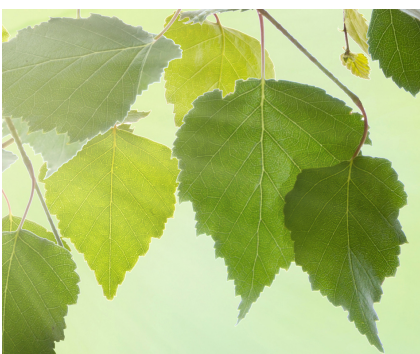
## FALL PROGRAM CHOICES

- **Fall Wreath:** Learn to create a cute, inexpensive fall wreath with felt.



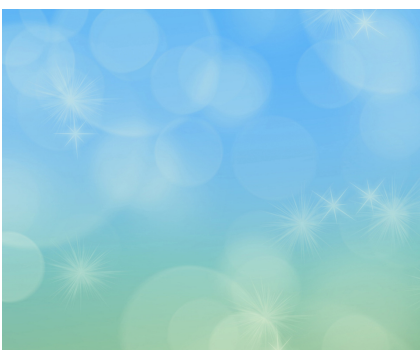
## WINTER PROGRAM CHOICES
