Shelby County 4-H had 384 4-H members (including Cloverbuds) enrolled in 2020-2021. There are 43 club leaders who share their knowledge and love of 4-H with its members. Our 4-H program continues to grow because of the great 4-H clubs, leaders and members in Shelby County 4-H actively recruiting new members.

Shelby County 4-H has 13 community clubs, 3 SPIN Clubs, and 2 Cloverbud Clubs. Highlights from the year included 16 workshops that helped 4-H'ers learn more about projects and increase their knowledge. Craft day workshops and 4-H Fire-Up were led by Federation members, which let them use and enhance their leadership skills. 3 Cloverbud only workshops were offered serving 45 youth.

Explore 4-H Virtual Workshops were offered to youth in Coles, Cumberland, Moultrie, Douglas and Shelby Counties from January through April. Workshops were held monthly via Zoom. The workshops included assembling first aid kits, building Can Can Robots, trebuchets and stomp rockets. This was the first year these workshops were offered and Shelby County 4-H'ers were excited to participate with 96 joining in on the fun.

Shelby County 4-H had four clubs apply for Farm Credit Community Improvement Grants. Moweaqua Rustlers provided improvements to the goat barn and Shelby Showstoppers purchased trees to provide much needed shade around the fairgrounds. The Shelby County Cloverbuds 4-H Club used the grant to purchase compost and new mulch to spruce up the community garden at HSHS Good Shepherd Hospital in Shelbyville. The Shelby Sparklers improved the Veterans Memorial at Sigel Park by planting flowers. Thank you to Farm Credit for their continued support to Shelby County 4-H Clubs.

Shelby County 4-H was excited to have our 4-H fair in person this summer! We missed seeing all the smiling faces in 2020. There were 216 4-H'ers who exhibited 1,439 exhibits. There were 51 Cloverbuds that displayed 95 exhibits. At the IL State Fair General Projects Show, there were 58 members that exhibited with 15 awarded champion, 10 awarded reserve and 5 awarded Inspire Awards. Shelby County 4-H livestock exhibitors also placed well in the livestock shows.

Thank you to the 4-H leaders who continuously work to make Shelby County 4-H Clubs strong in their community service work, leadership and public speaking opportunities. Our leaders are the heart of Shelby County 4-H and we couldn't do it without them.









Illinois 4-H Experience Award

Illinois 4-H challenges youth to try new things, experiment in project areas they may enjoy and explore opportunities around the state and country. This is the fifth year for the Illinois 4-H Experience Recognition award. The Experience Award offers recognition for members who participate in activities and events. There are lots of activities you can do as a 4-H member ranging from club to national events.

The award is based on four dimensions of experience: Participation, Community Service, Leadership and Project learning.

The Bronze level award requires members meet 1 experience in each of the four dimensions. The Silver level award requires members meet 2 experiences in each of the four dimensions with at least two of those being at the county level or above. The Gold level award requires members to complete 4 experiences in each of the four dimensions with at least 2 of those experiences beyond the county level.

This is the fifth year Shelby County 4-H members have participated in this awards program. There were a total of 34 applications as well as two that were sent to State Fair for judging.
