



To Make the Best **BETTER** **Shelby County 4-H** *Community Service Project*



4-H Member Challenge

Each Shelby County 4-H member (including Cloverbuds) is being challenged to do three community service projects either with their club or acting as an individual 4-H member. Working as an individual 4-H member means the group/project that you are helping understands that you are representing Shelby County 4-H. ***Working with school or church groups or other extra curricular activities DOES NOT COUNT!*** Two of the projects must be service related meaning helping or doing something. Donating items can count as one project. The projects must be completed during the 2020-2021 4-H year starting on September 1, 2020 and completed by August 31, 2021. If the member meets the challenge, the member will receive a community service medal and will be recognized at Achievement Night. Members can list the community service activities on their year-end records for credit but do not have to complete records to receive the community service medal.

Examples for 4-H members individual challenge:

- Note - Members can count projects done with their club for their individual challenge
- Bring food items to International Night. (Donation)
- Angel Tree/Toy Depot shopping (as a 4-H member) (Service)
- Collecting items for a charity example: Pride Packages (Service)
- Collecting school supplies (as a 4-H member) (Service)
- Working at the Festival of Lights (as a 4-H member) (Service)
- Community Involvement - Participating as 4-H members in parades, Trunk or Treats, etc. (Service)
- Caroling at a nursing home/retirement home (Service)
- Others as approved per the Extension office
