Hands-on community service, conservation, and environmental education are key components the <u>4-H Green Communities Tree Program</u> happening this spring in 31 counties throughout Illinois.



Illinois 4-H is partnering with the Illinois Soil and Water Conservation Districts Forestry Committee to address the decline of native oak savannas by providing 25 oak seedlings (in containers) to these counties.

If you see your county shaded in green below and are interested in helping plant these trees, let your local Extension office know! They will be coordinating a workday in late March-early April to plant these trees together on a public space of approximately ½ acre in your county.
