4-H Clubs & COVID

- 1.) Anyone attending a 4-H meeting must wear face coverings (that cover the nose and mouth)
 - At indoor meetings, all members and meeting attendees must wear face coverings throughout the whole meeting or event, except for when eating and drinking.
 - At outdoor meetings, all members and meeting attendees are encouraged to wear face coverings at all times and must wear face coverings when social distancing is not possible.
- 2.) Social distancing of at least 6 feet between attendees from different households must be followed.
- 3.) Objects should not be shared by attendees unless sanitized between each individual use.
- 4.) Clubs should consider using pre-packaged food and set up for individual servings.
- 5.) Attendance should be taken at meetings. All youth & adults present **must** sign in as part of this process.
- 6.) Hand sanitizer should be present at sign-in areas and/or soap should be available in restrooms at meeting sites. Attendees should wash or sanitize their hands regularly before, during and after meetings.
