Rabbit & Woodworking Award – sponsored by David Ratermann

<u>1<sup>st</sup> Year Member Award</u> – any 1<sup>st</sup> Year Member 8-18 that submits a completed <u>Personal Record</u> (maybe hand written) or <u>Member Activity online form</u>

<u>5</u><sup>th</sup> <u>Year Member Award</u> – any 5<sup>th</sup> Year Member that submits a completed <u>Personal Record</u> (maybe hand written) or <u>Member Activity online form</u>

**<u>President Award</u>**-Requires a <u>President Award Application</u> completed by club leader.

**Secretary Award**-Must include completed secretary book with bylaws, attendance and minutes.

<u>Treasurer Award</u>-Based on completed treasurer book, with completed audit, and correct number of signatures.

**Reporter Award**-Club reports should be turned in; in a binder or report folder, include all reports written and newspaper clippings, etc.

### State Awards Age 8-18

- 1. <u>Experience Recognition</u> Recognition of members age 8-18 who are involved in a diverse spectrum of 4-H experiences (club, county, multi-county, state, national, & international levels). Members will submit the My Illinois 4-H Experience Application
- 2. <u>Illinois Holstein-Friesian Association Recognition Award</u> Awarded to members who exhibit a dairy animal during the current year 4-H Shows and complete a <u>member activities/dairy project award</u>.
