Cloverbud Recognition – any Cloverbud that submits a hand written **Cloverbud Award Application** will be recognized.

Cloverbud Outstanding Member of the Year- presented to the top member age 5-7 that completes the **Cloverbud Award Application**.

Members Age 8-18

All applications 8-18 must be typed.

Engage Recognition – Recognizes all members 8-18 of 4-H for their participation (no application).

Outstanding Member of the Year- presented to the top two outstanding members of Clinton County 4-H that complete the, by the following age groups. Complete **Outstanding Member of the Year Application**:

- Junior Outstanding Member Age 8-12
- Senior Outstanding Member Age 13-18

Project Awards- presented to the top scoring member who submits a **Member Activities/ Project Award Application (s)** in any of the 11 project categories. Applications must score at least 25 points to be eligible.

1st Year Member Award – any 1st Year Member 8-18 that submits a completed **Personal Record (maybe hand written) or Member Activity online form**

5th Year Member Award – any 5th Year Member that submits a completed **Personal Record (maybe hand written) or Member Activity online form**

President Award - Requires a **President Award Application** completed by club leader.

Secretary Award - Must include **completed secretary book** with bylaws, attendance and minutes.

Treasurer Award - Based on **completed treasurer book**, with completed audit, and correct number of signatures.

Reporter Award - Club reports should be turned in; in a binder or report folder, include all reports written and newspaper clippings, etc.

State Awards Age 8-18
