<b>Formal Speech</b>		
<p><i>A speech that shares the presenter’s own unique view intended to motivate, persuade, or inform an audience and may include a call to action.</i></p>	<p><b>Original Oratory</b> – Deliver a speech on any topic you want</p>	<p>Self-written</p> <p>Notes are allowed</p> <p>No props</p>
<b>2. Illustrated Speech</b>		
<p><i>An Illustrated speech may be used to inform, or persuade/motivate the audience using a visual aid.</i></p>	<p><b>How-to demonstration</b> – Show the audience how to do something</p> <p><b>Object lesson</b> – Use objects as metaphors to share a message</p> <p><b>Educational model</b> – Draw or use a diagram to explain a topic</p>	<p>Self-written</p> <p>Notes are allowed</p> <p>Visual aids may be 2D, 3D, or digital.</p> <p>May include audience participation</p> <p>Digital visual aids must be stored on USB flash drive</p>
