Pondering Pizza: A Slice of Agriculture



Kit Objectives

Some Notes on Using the Kits

<u>Kit Contents</u> - The AgriLearning Kits are intended to be "resource materials" kits. While some hands-on supplies are provided, because of the number of activities included in the various books and guides within each kit, such supplies are only included to complete some of the lessons.

<u>Illinois Learning Standards</u> - Again, because of the sheer number of activities available in each kit, it is not feasible to show specifically how every activity can be used to meet the Learning Standards. Instead, a more general correlation to the overall kit contents has been provided to assist teachers in meeting the Standards.

<u>Use with AgriScience Kits</u> - In some cases, the AgriLearning Kits have specifically been developed to complement the existing AgriScience Kits. The Eggsploring Poultry: Cracking the Egg AgriLearning Kit can be used in conjunction with the Eggciting Experiments: Chick Incubation and Embryology AgriScience Kit. The Dairy Cow Capers: Exploring Dairy Farming and Nutrition AgriLearning Kit may be used along with the Dairy Delights: Good Nutrition from Milk AgriScience Kit.

<u>Web sites</u> - To further assist teachers and students seeking information on agricultural topics, a list of related web site addresses has been provided in each kit.

<u>Consumable Items</u> - Each AgriLearning Kit is supplied with a variety of consumable items, such as the Illinois Ag Mags and other informational handouts (which may be given to the students), craft supplies, etc. After each use, such items will be replenished at the check-out location.

<u>Farm Facts and Career Information</u> - Each AgriLearning Kit includes materials containing general information on U.S. and Illinois agriculture, as well as information on agricultural careers. Teachers are encouraged to share this information with their students.
