#### **Entry Requirements**

- 1. "Christian County 4-H Show Book" and the year "2021" must be shown somewhere in your design.
- 2. Use any fair or project theme.
- 3. Artwork must be created by a current Christian 4-H member (including cloverbuds).
- 4. Your artwork can either be handdrawn or design using computer software. All entires printed in black ink only with a white backgroun/on white paper.
- 6. No entries with trademarked characters/symbols other than the 4-H clover accepted.
- 7. Put your name and club on the BACK of your design in PENCIL.

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#### **2021 AG INNOVATORS EXPERIENCE**

This next year's theme will be **Curbing Our Carbon Appetite**. The 2021 4-H Ag Innovators Experience, Curbing Our Carbon Appetite Challenge, is a series of interactive, hands-on activities that help youth understand why everyone has a role to play in addressing climate change. Participants will learn how human activity including burning of fossil fuels, deforestation, soil mismanagement, and unwise food systems are increasing atmospheric carbon and contributing to climate change. The activity leads them through an exploration of actions that three carbon influencer groups—agriculture, business and industry, and individuals and families—can take to reduce atmospheric carbon.
