



This is a great opportunity to for teens to develop their speaking skills, while preparing them to advocate for issues and programs at the local, Unit and the State 4-H level. The skills gained will help them share their local 4-H story with donors, key community leaders and groups, and even serve as ambassadors to other youth, encouraging them to be a part of the Illinois 4-H program.

Additionally, once teens complete the Speaking for Illinois 4-H Training, they are eligible to participate in Legislative Connection which involves teens in meeting with Illinois State Legislators in Springfield. We have two sets of tentative dates March 16-17, and April 6-7, on hold with the Secretary of State's office with hopes of meeting in person during 2022 however that will be dependent on the status of CDC and UIUC Extension Health guidelines.



Host an international youth this summer

International students come to IL each summer and stay with a host family for about 4 weeks. Host a Japanese or South Korean youth this summer through States' 4-H International! Expand your family's cultural understanding, learn about new foods and customs, and possibly learn a new language, all while sharing your own. Your children will build lifelong friendships and will gain new perspectives on their own country, too! Families are needed for July 23 through August 18 (tentative dates). Applications are accepted until all placements are made. There is no cost for this program.

Students are matched with a host sibling by age gender and interests. So families hosting, must have a child the between 12-18.

Host family selection is dependent on completion of an application and screening process, as well as student availability and personality compatibility.


