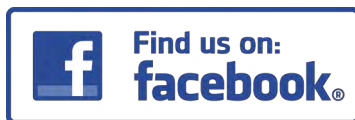

Awards are due October 15th!

4-H Club Fiscal Paperwork

All 4-H Clubs **without** an EIN complete the Indication of Financial Activity Statement.

All 4-H Clubs **with** an EIN complete the club's fiscal review and submit the (2-page) **4-H Club Annual Financial Statement** to the Extension office in the following ways:

- separate 2-page financial statement included with the *Treasurer Record Book*
- Make certain bank statements, cancelled checks, copies of bills paid, deposit slips, proper signatories, and receipts for cash are all reviewed.

All paperwork must be submitted to the office by October 1st!

I know it is hard to believe but awards deadline is September 15, 2021! All awards must be submitted to the University of Illinois Extension office in Effingham County by close of business at 4:30 p.m. on September 15, 2021! All you need to do is fill out your award application just like the others have. Below you will find all the information, along with the link for the application regarding a variety of awards you too are qualified to apply for.

The Experience Award

The Experience Award offers recognition for members who participate in activities and events. There are always lots of activities you can do as a 4-H member ranging from club to national events.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to 4-H members of all ages.

APPLICATION PROCESS

DOWNLOAD the Experience Award Application - <https://4h.extension.illinois.edu/award/illinois-4-h-experience-award-individuals> and save to your computer. You can also check out the award tip sheet. We encourage you to work on this application throughout the year. Your county will provide you a local application deadline. Complete the application listing your experiences during one year in these 4 areas:

- ★ Participation
- ★ Community Service
- ★ Leadership
- ★ Project Learning

Bronze, Silver, & Gold Clover Award winners receive county recognition. Diamond and Emerald Clover Award winners will be honored at a state awards ceremony each fall. There is no limit to the number of members who can achieve each level... if you do the work, you get the award.

Your award level is determined by how many experiences you do in each area:

Bronze Clover Award: Complete at least 1 experience in each of the four dimensions.

Silver Clover Award: Complete at least 2 experiences in each of the four dimensions; at least 2 of those experiences must be at the County level or beyond.

Gold Clover Award: Complete 4 experiences in each of the four dimensions; at least 2 of those experiences must be BEYOND the County level.

Diamond Clover Award: Complete 6 or more experiences in ONE dimension; at least 4 of those experiences must be BEYOND the County level.

Emerald Clover Award: Complete 8 or more experiences in ONE dimension; at least 4 of those experiences must be BEYOND the County level PLUS at least 2 must be at the State or National level.

ATTENTION SECRETARIES & TREASURERS!

All your books must be submitted to the University of Illinois Extension office in Effingham County by close of business at 4:30 PM on September 15, 2021! Club Treasurer - YOU MUST HAVE AN AUDIT COMMITTEE SIGN the form in your treasurer book stating they have audited your records. Your 4-H club will NOT be in compliance with the requirements set by the IRS.

Effingham County 4-H

Electricity Award

This award recognizes 4-H members who excel in the electricity project.

ELEGIBILITY

- o Members should have constructed and displayed an electrical exhibit and completed 4-H electric project records.
- o 4-H members can receive this award only once.

APPLICATION

Submit the application to your county Extension office on the date it requires for award applications. Counties must make requests to the state office by Sept. 15 annually.

RECOGNITION

The Energy Education Council will provide one plaque to each county recognizing one 4-H member's outstanding achievements in electricity. The award is presented locally.

Officer Awards

Special prizes are given to the following top club officers:

President: MEMBER'S APPLICATION PROCESS: Write an essay about your leadership as the club's president. Include your involvement in preparing the club agenda, planning programs, assisting members, holding officer meetings, etc. which might give a clue into how you personally led your 4-H club.

Vice - President: MEMBER'S APPLICATION PROCESS: Write an essay about your leadership as the club's vice-president. Include your involvement in preparing the club agenda, planning programs, assisting members, holding officer meetings, etc. which might give a clue into how you personally led your 4-H club.

Secretary: MEMBER'S APPLICATION PROCESS: Submit secretary book and all supplemental material. The secretary's book may be typed instead of handwritten, but all additional sections of the secretary's book must be completed.

Treasurer: MEMBER'S APPLICATION PROCESS: Submit treasurer book, bank statements and all supplemental material. **THE AUDIT MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED.**

Reporter: MEMBER'S APPLICATION PROCESS: Submit reports submitted to the paper or the office.

The following criteria is used in judging the officer awards: neatness; thorough completion of the books by the member; accuracy of the information provided; and the scrapbooks should include the club name, officers', leaders' and members' names.

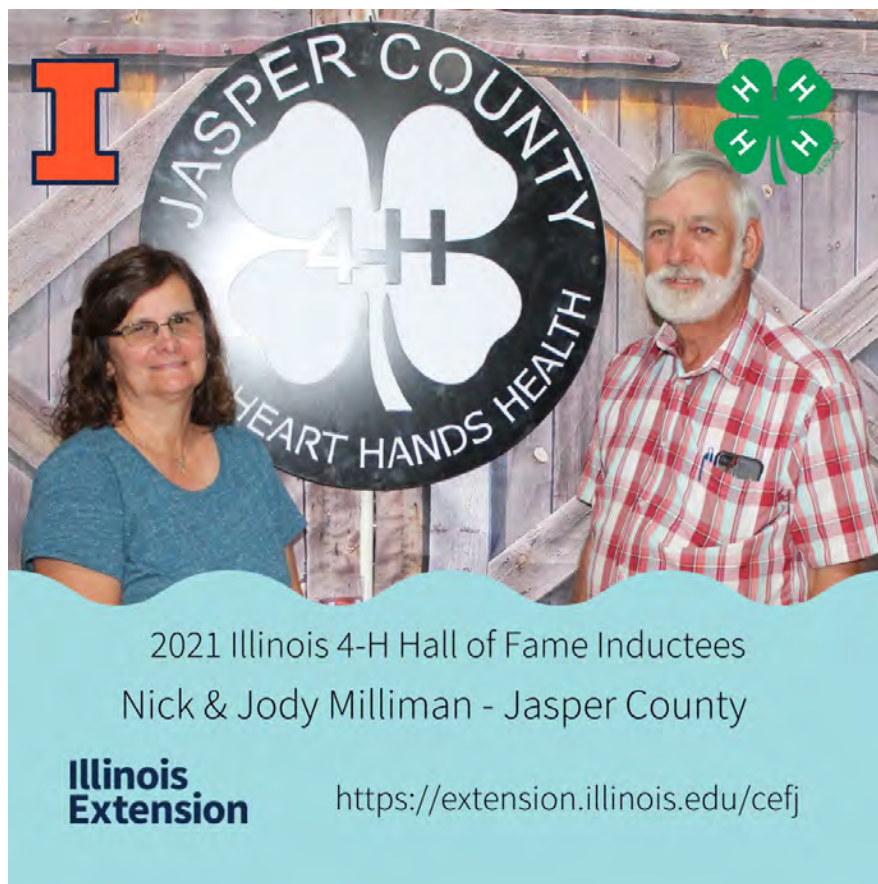

Is your 4-H club's secretary or treasurer's record book up-to-date? All 4-H clubs with a checking or savings account must complete both pages of the 4-H Club Annual Financial Statement form at the end of each 4-H year. Submit this statement along with other required forms and officer books to your county Extension office by the deadline. The financial statement includes a report of income and expenses for the 4-H club checking account (page 1) and/or savings account (page 2). The club treasurer and club leader must sign on page 2 of this form to verify the information is correct. Also on page 2, the Fiscal Review Committee (a group of 2 or 3 youth and adults who do not have signatory rights on the club's bank account(s)) must review the financial records of the 4-H club for the past year and sign to indicate they have found everything in good order. Contact the Extension Office if you need a copy of the club's financial statement.

Extraordinary volunteers inducted into Illinois 4-H Hall of Fame

Illinois 4-H volunteers empower and prepare youth for success as the program relies on its more than 15,000 volunteers to fill key leadership and mentoring roles. Longtime volunteers and former staff members were recently honored by the Illinois 4-H Foundation for their selfless dedication to the University of Illinois Extension 4-H youth development program.

In 2021, 71 individuals received the Foundation Hall of Fame Award, presented during a virtual ceremony Aug. 17. Four of the honorees are being named posthumously.

The Illinois 4-H Foundation established the statewide Hall of Fame in 2005 to honor and celebrate extraordinary 4-H alumni, volunteers, and former 4-H staff. Those inducted have a track record of exemplary service to 4-H or outstanding career and community achievement and were nominated by either county University of Illinois Extension staff or by the Illinois 4-H Foundation Board. Each inductee receives a commemorative Hall of Fame medallion.

“These volunteers are a model of 4-H values,” says Angie Barnard, Illinois 4-H Foundation executive director. “All of our volunteers are valuable, but this award honors those that go above and beyond. These are volunteers that helped shape not only individuals, but generations of 4-H members. The Illinois 4-H Foundation is extremely proud to be able to provide this honor to thank them for their service to this wonderful organization.

Illinois 4-H programs reach nearly 120,000 youth each year through 4-H clubs, camps, educational programs, workshops, and conferences held in communities, schools, parks, and homes across Illinois. Volunteers fill key leadership and mentoring roles throughout the state.

“Many volunteers have a tradition of 4-H in their family or were 4-H members themselves,” Barnard says. “More and more though, adults brand new to the 4-H experience are seeing the value of the life skills development program and volunteering for the first time. 4-H has volunteer opportunities that fit such a wide variety of time, skills, and talents.”
