



Today's 4-H'er – Tomorrow's Volunteer

This award is being sponsored by the Bob and Arnieta Schultz family. Bob and Arnieta were long time 4-H leaders who continually volunteered and worked "to make the best better" for Coles County 4-H. The award emphasizes the value of giving time and talent back to 4-H by helping your 4-H club or county 4-H activities and for the work done to support regional and state 4-H events.

Award: A winner of the award will be chosen from each of two age divisions - 12 years and younger or 13 years and older. The winner in age division 12 years and younger will receive a \$25 check and a trophy. The winner in age division 13 years and older will receive a \$50 check and a trophy.

Requirements:

1. Open to any 4-H member
2. 4-H member must submit completed application (see form on back) to 4-H club leader by deadline (in August at completion of current 4-H year)

CLUB ACTIVITIES:
2pts for each activity

Examples: provided recreation, snacks, etc at club meeting; set-up or clean-up for meeting; assisted with club project activity; helped new 4-H member with their project; (club offices held are not considered volunteer activity)

COUNTY ACTIVITIES:
5 pts for each activity

Examples: secured donations for county BBQ, worked at BBQ; hosted 4-H Center at Fair, helped a 4-H'er show their project, assembled 4-H newsletter, assisted at 4-H General Projects show, clean-up after livestock auction; helped with leaders' meeting, Achievement night, etc

REGIONAL OR STATE ACTIVITIES:
8 pts for each activity

Examples: Served on planning committee for youth conference or helped host at a conference; assisted with State Fair general exhibits judging; helped with Leaders' Forum
