With the Illinois Department of Ag's latest announcement, Crawford County 4-H will shift its 4-H poultry show to a *display option only* while the emergency rules are in place. **No live birds will be allowed.** Youth who exhibit a display will still be able to show at State Fair (pending their final decision in late June) and be eligible for awards and premiums. Only one class offered this year due to Bird flu and state requirements:

Prepare a display of your bird(s); you can choose to talk about one or multiple birds in the display. The display should include but is not limited to:

- photos of the animal from multiple angles
- being able to discuss the breed and anatomy of the animal and daily care and routine of the animal
- bring display on the day of Poultry show at the scheduled time
- bring display and participate in one-on-one judging if you wish to participate in the livestock auction
