

## **Effingham County 4-H Foundation Recognition Award**

## Guidelines:

- 1. Applicants must be a current member or alumni of an Effingham County 4-H Club.
- 2. Applicants must have been a 4-H member for at least 5 years.
- 3. The application should be typed, and the application form must be completed in full.
- 4. Applicants may only receive the \$250 Recognition Award one time.
- 5. Must have been a high school senior or currently enrolled in college 2022-2023.
- 6. Parent and leader signatures are required on application form.
- 7. The application form and two letters of recommendation (one from a 4-H leader and one from a non-family member such as teacher, employer, or other community leader), should be submitted to the Effingham County Extension office by 4:30 p.m., April 7, 2023. Letter of recommendation should be in a sealed envelope or emailed to logan1@illinois.edu directly from the individual writing the recommendation letter.
