First-Time 4-H Members

Are you new to 4-H? If you are a first time member and having problems following requirements in the show book, be sure to ask your leader or call the office. It is better to do things correctly ahead of time than to try to change paperwork on show day. We are here to help you!! Also, be sure to bring your goal sheets to the food, clothing, and general shows and your livestock records to clean-up to be checked.



Horse Show

Once again ALL 4-H members are required to wear a properly fitted horse helmet whenever mounted or driving at all 4-H horse & pony events, shows, activities, or practices. Helmet policies apply to all county, area, and state 4-H horse and pony events. If you are mounted on a horse you must have a helmet on.

Vet Checks

If you do your vet checks as a group (exp. your whole club on the same day) it will cut down on the costs.

Illinois Crop Scouting Competition for High School Age Youth



The Illinois Crop Scouting Competition is a one-day contest and will be held at the Crop Sciences Research & Ed. Center in Savoy, IL on August 4, 2021 Student teams of 2-5 high-school-aged youth (grades 9-12) with an adult coach will rotate through 10 outdoor stations at the University of Illinois South Farm fields to test their skills hands-on with topics such as identifying weeds, insects, and diseases, identifying the growth stages of corn and soybean plants, assessing abiotic injury, pesticide application, and integrated pest management.
