Cloverbud 4-H members do their project work as a group. Older members do their project work independently.

- O Use the **My 4-H Project Work** booklet to keep track of my goals and accomplishments (available at go.illinois.edu/effprojectworkbook)
- Give a talk/demonstration to my club about one of my projects
- Order my project books
- If doing a live animal project, complete ethics training
 - YQCA required <u>annually</u> if exhibiting Beef, Dairy, Goats, Sheep, or Swine
 - QAEC required <u>once</u> if exhibiting Cats, Dogs, Horses, Poultry, or Rabbits
 - Must be completed before submitting show registration entries

Participation

- (Parents are encouraged to attend meetings and volunteer when the leader needs help.)
- Read the **newsletter** and watch **email** for important information
- Like us on **Facebook** to see announcements and reminders
- Keep track of what I do during the year for my 4-H **Records**

Exhibiting

- Watch for **show dates** to be announced or view in ZSuite; exhibitors must be present for in-person judging
- Read the Exhibit Requirements for my projects in the Show Book, which is emailed to families in spring
- Register which of my projects I plan to exhibit (Being enrolled in a project does not automatically mean you will exhibit it, so registration is required.)

June 15 - General Projects/Livestcock
July 1- Rabbits

- Prepare my exhibits (Parents can guide and assist with project work, but members are expected to complete their exhibits themselves.)
