



Fashion Revue Instructions:

On the next page you will find a form to complete for the Fashion Revue. The announcer will read this description while you model your project at the Fashion Revue on Thursday. Be sure to complete the form so we have a description to read for you! This year the Fashion Revue will be in the new hospitality building by the food stand. Here are some general tips:

- Please limit your description to 100-200 words. This will give you enough time to model without having a description that is too long.
- Type or neatly print your description so it is easy to read. You may also type/write the description on another piece of paper and attach it to the form.
- Describe your outfit/item, including details on construction, style, and accessories. Suggestions of things to include:
 - Name (*required*)
 - Club (*required*)
 - Clothing project in which enrolled (*required*)
 - Indicate if purchased or sewn by member (*required*)
 - o Age
 - Type of garment: casual, dressy, etc
 - Where you will wear garment
 - Fiber content of garment
 - Special interests, hobbies
 - Involvement in community activities
 - Future career plans
