- Gear/Tackle will be provided. Recommend you bring a folding chair. If you want to bring your own rods, reels, and tackle we recommend: bobbers, lightweight hooks, small jigs, and 1 - 2 inch soft plastics.
- Parents will NOT be allowed to fish at this time.
