- 5) Please have proof of residence.
- 6) You must be present to participate. NO ONE may pick up for you.
- 7) We will do drive by distribution.
- 8) If you have a car, you will be lined up in numerical order.
- 9) Walk-ups will receive numbers in the order that you arrive.

**For the sake of everyone's safety, we reserve the right
to refuse service to anyone who:**

- 1) Exhibits disrespect, including verbal abuse towards staff, volunteers, or other participating community members.
- 2) Exhibits any indication of alcohol use.
- 3) Exhibits violent behavior.
- 4) Is smoking on the property.
- 5) Has weapons on their person.
- 6) Refuses to cooperate with or follow the practices and guidelines in place for the event.
