#### **Description of Job:**

The Commercial Agriculture Extra Help employee will support the implementation of projects at Ewing Demonstration Center for the purpose of research and demonstration of row-crop agriculture best management practices as directed by the specified County Director and under the leadership of the Extension Commercial Ag Educator.

#### **Organizational Relationship:**

The Commercial Agriculture Extra Help employee is administratively responsible to the University of Illinois Extension County Director. The employee will work collaboratively and under the programmatic supervision of designated academic professional staff.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

40% Work with Unit and Statewide Educator(s) to assist and support the work at Ewing Demonstration Center.

20% Assist Commercial Agriculture staff with agricultural education opportunities through outreach, workshops, and demonstrations

20% Assist with management of field trials and field days at the Ewing Demonstration Center (located in Franklin County). This would include data collection and assisting with the development and implementation of field trials.

10% Perform related duties as assigned.

Interaction includes, but not limited to, staff of multi-county unit, individuals in the community, and Extension offices throughout Illinois. Appreciation of diversity and a willingness to help are required.
