Absentee Rules Knox County 4-H General Project Show

4-H members are required to be with their exhibits for judging unless one of the following is true:

- 4-Her becomes ill
- Illness or death in the family
- Military Service
- Other excuse approved by the Program Coordinator

Remember, this year we also have the option of exhibiting virtually. Make sure to select "Virtual" when you are registering in FairEntry to utilize this option. If you are unable to attend the 4-H General Project Show with good cause, you must fill out an *Absentee Excuse Form by July 1*, stating a valid reason for not being present. The exhibitor, a parent/guardian, and the exhibitor's 4-H leader must sign this form. Forms that do not have all designated signatures (member, parent, *and* leader) are considered incomplete. Hair appointments, doctor appointments, vacations, etc. are NOT considered good cause. Please request work schedules that allow you to be present for judging if at all possible. Advance notice of fair dates should give sufficient time to most employers.

If your *Absentee Excuse Form* is approved, an *Absentee Exhibitor Form* must be attached to each exhibit. Answer all questions thoroughly in your own words. Answers may be printed or typed. The *Absentee Excuse Form* and *Absentee Exhibitor Form* are available on the county webpage. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to procure these forms and the required signatures by the deadlines.

If the 4-H member is not present for judging and an Absentee Exhibitor Form is not attached to the exhibit, the exhibit will not be judged and is not eligible to receive an award or premium. Absentee projects are not state fair eligible.
