- Applications must be turned in by **4:30 pm on April 1.**
(No late applications will be accepted.)
You *may* be required to attend an interview.

Scoring Criteria for the High School Scholarship Application Process:

4-H Activities-	15 points
Offices Held-	5 points
Awards-	5 points
Recommendation Letter-	5 points
Other Extra Curricular Activities-	10 points
Questions-	60 points @ 10 points each

The Extension office will procure a panel of qualified readers. The applicants' names will not be available to the readers. Each reader will provide a score with the total amount possible being 100.

Total of four scholarships are available. Potential of four applicants winning the following amount:

- Applications with an average score of 90 points or above will receive \$1,000
- Applications with an average score of 80-89 points will receive \$500
- Applications with an average score of 75-79 points will receive \$250
- Applications with an average score of 74 points or below will not receive a scholarship
