Dear 4-H Families and Friends,

First and foremost, congratulations to all of our 4-H members who are graduating from High School this year. We are proud of all of your accomplishments.



May is a great time to start deciding what you are bringing to the 4-H fair. So, I want to spend a couple of minutes explaining a little about the 4-H Fair Entry system. To make your fair entries, please go to the website https://fairentry.com. You will use the "find your fair" option to search for your fair and sign in with your 4-H Online information.

Once you are in the 4-H Fair Entry system, you will see a welcome message. Please read this carefully. It will provide details on measures being taken at all 4-H shows to help mitigate COVID. Each 4-H member will make their entry. Once each member of the family has completed their entries, you can submit your entries. We ask that you are very patient and you give yourself plenty of time to complete the entries before the deadline(s) outlined in this newsletter.

Here are a few tips that might make it go faster.

- First, review the 4-H fair book and the classes that you plan to enter. Your Fair Book can be found on our website at https://extension.illinois.edu/hkmw/4-h-henderson-county or at https://extension.illinois.edu/hkmw/4-h-warren-county. Scroll to the bottom of the page and look under the "Fairs and Shows" tab. The fair book is still in draft form.
- Second, write out the class name. Keep in mind you can only have one General Show project per category for this is based on your level in the 4-H project.
   Please review your project enrollment in 4-H online before you move into the 4-H Fair Entry system.
- Third, enter into the 4-H Fair Entry system and click on the projects that you
  plan to take to the fair. You will notice that you will select the word "choose"
  many times. Once you have completed your selection, you will see all the classes
  that you entered.

Please contact Jill with any questions you may have about the 4-H Fair Entry process. We are happy to help, but ask that you don't wait until the last minute to register.

# Illinois 4-H is being asked for help with an important research project!

I-Pollinate is a citizen science initiative and will be offering \$100 to each of 54 small "study" gardens established by Illinois 4-H members this spring, if they agree to report back on-line their observations of which annual, ornamental flowers pollinators prefer on their gardens. The task at hand though is to spread these gardens out statewide – so only one garden per county will be allowed until all 54 are registered. Leaders can apply for funding by completing a training and registering their garden. These are small garden plots with specific plants – literally only  $4' \times 6'$  in size. A detailed training will open April 26, and data collection won't

start until National Pollinator Week June 21, but I wanted to give you a teaser now! Be thinking of who to invite from your local areas! Along with the \$100 reimbursement for supplies and materials, 4-H members completing the reporting observations will receive an I-Pollinator Certificate; permanent sign for their garden; and an honorary pin! Good stuff for a future entomology project display!

This project is designed by Dr. Alex Harmon-Threatt of the U of I with the support of the Illinois Farm Bureau and Illinois extension. More information can be found at ipollinate.illinois.edu

# Are you Fair Ready?

Your 4-H team is busy working to plan the 2021 4-H Fair in a way that is safe for all participants and volunteers. We need you to do your part to make sure you are ready for the fair. Remember that all members should have attended 4 meetings to be eligible to show at the 4-H Fair. If you are short on meetings, check out the virtual meeting option on page 7. You must also have given a talk or demonstration, although some clubs might have additional requirements. Think you are going to struggle to meet these requirements? Reach out to Jill to form a plan!

# **Fair Entry Deadline**

Members can make their fair entries by visiting <u>fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/15168</u> for Henderson or <u>fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/15246</u> for Warren. Once you are in the fair entry program, you will see a welcome message. Each 4-H member will make their entry as an individual. You should see a list of family members eligible to exhibit. You will make entries one youth at a time. Cloverbuds do NOT need to use the 4-H Entry System. They will just bring their project the day of the General Project Show.

Families with multiple children, once you are done selecting projects for the first child you will need to select "register another Exhibitor" to enter your second child's projects and so on. Once the family is completed you can then submit everyone at once. Otherwise, once you submit you will need to wait until the office approves those entries before you can enter your second child's projects.

We ask that you are very patient and you give yourself plenty of time to complete the entries before the deadlines listed below. The fair entry system will close at 11:59 p.m. on the deadlines listed below. We will not schedule a Fair Entry Night. If you need one on one help we encourage you to make special arrangements with the office. We are happy to help, but ask that you don't wait until the last minute to register.

# Check out the Masters at this year's State Fair

Each county may send one individual entry into the Illinois State Fair Master Showmanship Contest. The State contest begins at 7 p.m. Friday, August 13. Exhibitors must be at least 14 and no older than 18 (as of 9/1/20). You need to supply your own animals for the contest, but may make prior arrangements to borrow animals from exhibitors at the fair. The contest is sponsored by Illinois Farm Bureau and RFD Radio.

#### **State Fair Nomination Processes**

If you are taking a sheep or goat to the State Fair, don't forget State Fair has moved to a self-nomination process for all **live-show** sheep and goats. The self-nomination form must be completed March 15 - May 15, 2021. A clear, close up image must be taken of the ear with scrapie tag and included with the form. Completed forms and photos must be taken to the Extension Office by the deadline for a signature. Copies were sent via email and mail. Please call our office if you are needing to nominate animals for the **premiere show**.




# **4-H Digs Dinosaurs**
