 - Video each of your classes HORIZONTALLY.
 - Follow the pattern given and have your videographer stand in the marked spot according to each pattern.
 - Dressage videos can be a little longer to accommodate for the pattern.
 - Follow guidelines on the Packet of Patterns doc to video pleasure class
 - For costume class, send a video similar to the pleasure class instructions, but only at a walk.

 - Submit **each** of your horse show class videos here with the **correct name format**
 - The file description should include the 4-H member's name, project name, and specific show class **as it appears on the virtual show bill** (example: Jane Doe, Horse, Showmanship 8-11).

 - a response video not to exceed 3 minutes in which you demonstrate or practice what you learned - email Lisa at lisa.kunzie13@gmail.com (Tip: upload it to your Google Drive and share the link to Lisa)
 - an email explaining what clinic you watched, three things you learned, and how you plan to practice this with your horse - send to Lisa at lisa.kunzie13@gmail.com
 - Stay on the ZOOM call after the meeting and present your information to Lisa
 - Call Lisa Kunzie at 815-715-2068 to explain what clinic you watched, three things you learned, and how you plan to practice this with your horse
