  - Log into <u>4H Fair Online System</u> to make your entry for the Horse project
  - Horse Entry Card upload picture of info of each class on Fair Entry (<u>find entry card info here</u>)
  - Video each of your classes HORIZONTALLY.
    - Follow the pattern given and have your videographer stand in the marked spot according to each pattern.
    - Dressage videos can be a little longer to accommodate for the pattern.
    - Follow guidelines on the Packet of Patterns doc to video pleasure class
    - For costume class, send a video similar to the pleasure class instructions, but only at a walk.
  - <u>Video Upload Instructions</u> (Phone or Computer)
  - Video Upload Site (BOX)
    - Submit **each** of your horse show class videos here with the *correct name format*
    - The file description should include the 4-H member's name, project name, and specific show class *as it appears on the virtual show bill* (example: Jane Doe, Horse, Showmanship 8-11).

Warning: we may not be able to find your file without this description, so do not skip this step.

### c. REQUIREMENT TO EXHIBIT AT THE VIRTUAL SHOW:

- You have ONE WEEK from this meeting to submit a clinic response in the form of ONE of the following:
  - a response video not to exceed 3 minutes in which you demonstrate or practice what you learned - email Lisa at <u>lisa.kunzie13@gmail.com</u> (Tip: upload it to your Google Drive and share the link to Lisa)
  - an email explaining what clinic you watched, three things you learned, and how you plan to practice this with your horse - send to Lisa at <u>lisa.kunzie13@gmail.com</u>
  - Stay on the ZOOM call after the meeting and present your information to Lisa
  - Call Lisa Kunzie at 815-715-2068 to explain what clinic you watched, three things you learned, and how you plan to practice this with your horse
  - DUE TUESDAY, JULY 28
  - When you enter the virtual show at 4-H Fair Entry online, there will be an "acknowledgement" box to check to ensure you have completed this requirement.
