Illinois Gardener Training is a self-paced online course for those interested in learning all about gardening in Illinois.

Upon training completion, those interested get the opportunity to apply for your local Extension Master Gardener program when their application period opens.

**Training starts June 12, 2023**

13 modules – Introduction, Botany; Soils and Fertilizers; Diagnostics and Plant Diseases; Entomology; Integrated Pest Management; Annuals/Perennials; Trees, Shrubs and Woody Vines; Lawns; Small Fruits and Tree Fruits; Vegetables; Composting/Organic Gardening; and Living with Wildlife.

Each module consists of several captioned videos with audio. A strong internet connection is highly recommended. Plan on 14 weeks to complete, assuming 4 hours per week. \$300 registration includes the manual. Local fees may apply. Participation in this online course does not guarantee acceptance as a Master Gardener volunteer.
