

Jo Daviess County Beef Association Scholarship

The Jo Daviess County Beef Association Scholarship Fund has been established to provide financial assistance to Jo Daviess County residents studying agricultural related fields. The Beef Association Scholarship committee is responsible for the selection of the scholarship recipients.

Scholarships will be awarded as funds permit.

Eligibility:

- Jo Daviess County, Illinois resident
- Must be enrolled in agriculture, or agricultural related field
- Must be enrolled in a two- or four-year program
- Must be accepted at chosen school, college, or university
- Must be a full-time student, 12 hours minimum per semester, auditing of classes cannot be included in minimum.
- Must be willing to assist association at one of our community events

Special consideration will be given to members of the Jo Daviess County Beef Association and their immediate family.

The Beef Association Scholarship committee based on the questions that the applicants answer will make selection. The Application Questions must be typewritten, maximum two pages, 12 Pt. type.

A new application must be submitted each year. Scholarship recipients cannot receive the scholarship for more than 4 years. PLEASE CLEAR, CONCISE APPLICATIONS ARE APPRECIATED!

This scholarship will be paid directly to the winner in one installment: during the first semester or quarter. A written verification letter of enrollment from the school will be required to receive the scholarship. **This information must be sent to the Beef Association no later than September 1, 2021.** If not, the scholarship may be given to an alternate.

If applicant wishes to apply for a 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year scholarship, a final second semester grade report must be sent to the Beef Association by June 1, 2022. This is needed to show proof that the applicant was enrolled and completed the previous semester.

Winners will be requested to work at one of the summer events that support the scholarship and to attend the Annual Banquet to present information on their educational accomplishments.

If for some reason the recipient is unable to enroll or withdraws from school, the awarded scholarship will be returned in full to the Beef Association Scholarship Fund.

Alternates may be selected as appropriate.

A letter indicating whether they are the recipients of a scholarship will be sent to each applicant.

2. How have your school courses and/or previous work experiences prepared you for your chosen field of study?
3. Write a brief summary of your leadership and other activities (both school and non-school)
