BEEF WEIGH-IN:

Weigh-In will be held at the <u>Schnitzler Farm located at 5825 S. Schnitzler Rd.,</u> <u>Elizabeth</u>. This will take place on <u>Saturday, February 6, 2021 .</u>

<u>I will not be sending beef weigh-in forms this year</u>. You will register online using the following link:

When you register, you will need to sign up for a specific time. You will need to tell me the names of all the participants included in your "family", how many animals you will be bringing, and how many EID tags you will need.

I have set times every 20 minutes. We are hoping to eliminate as much contact as we can and be as safe as possible, so the following safety measures will be in place for beef weigh-in. 1. No extra people will be allowed. Only the exhibitor of the animal that is currently being processed OR one parent/guardian will be allowed out of their vehicles at a time. NOT BOTH. 2. Only the exhibitor OR one parent/guardian will be allowed in the "processing" area at a time. 3. Everyone must wear a mask.

All beef exhibitors who plan to cross county lines to participate in other shows, participate at the IL State Fair, and who would like to exhibit in the rate of gain class at the 4-H fair... must go through beef weigh in.

You must be registered by January 31.

- If you are submitting a hard copy, please include name, age, and club on the back lightly in pencil. If you are emailing it to me, please include the information in the email.

WOULD YOU BE INTERESTED IN BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE FIRST ILLINOIS 4-H VIRTUAL ESPORTS SPIN CLUB?

With eSports becoming one of the largest growing tech industries in the world, with an annual revenue of \$1.5 billion with an expectation to reach \$2.2 billion by 2023, it is time that our youth become poised and ready to meet the demands of this growing field.

Are you **at least 12 years old and own a computer or gaming system**? This year Illinois 4-H released a pilot curriculum focused on the growing field of electronic sports, or eSports, and we would like to pilot it with you! As a pilot, we hope to add to and modify the curriculum based on the feedback and input of the youth involved. Under the direction of Illinois 4-H Computer Science Innovator Eric Li, youth will be virtually guided (using Zoom) through the eSports Pilot curriculum, learn the basics of the eSports field, and learn about the hardware and software that makes eSports possible. In addition, youth will be able to play and practice their favorite games as a team, and potentially compete in one or more eSports competitions through the Spring and Summer.

Registration for this opportunity is open and closes on <u>Jan. 15</u>, with meetings beginning the third week of January. Schedule and goals will be determined/presented in the first meeting with plans on meeting at least twice a month (and more frequently before competitions).


