





Life at 4-H Camp

We will again be attending Rock River Christian Camp, in Polo, Illinois. 4-H Day Camp will offer a variety of safely-led activities such as: archery, crate stacking, arts and crafts, hiking, zip-line, team building and large group games, as well as end each day with a camp evening program.

4-H Camp is open to a total of 100 youth each day that are between the ages 8-14 by June 14, 2022. Campers do not have to be a 4-H member to attend 4-H Camp. Youth may choose to attend, one, two or all three days for 4-H day camp. Camp runs from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. with check-in and check-out procedures.

Camp Location

4-H Camp is at Rock River Christian Camp in Polo, IL. Rock River Christian Camp has 94 acres that have been transformed over the years into a beautiful facility for youth and adults.

Staff at RRCC are certified in First Aid, CPR and AED. There is a qualified first aid person at camp at all times. Campers select their own activities, and are supervised at all times. 4-H Youth Development staff extensively train all camp counselors. We strive to maintain an environment that both encourages personal growth and creates an unforgettable summer experience.



Host family selection is dependent on completion of an application and screening process, as well as student availability and personality compatibility.






The poster must be a digital design and can be created in any platform. The design should be 8.5 X 11 in size and at least 300DPI. Files should be in JPEG or PNG format.

Any media can be used (paint, crayons, stickers, etc.) to create a flat poster. Hard copies can be dropped off or mailed to the office and digital pictures or scans should be JPEG or PDF format.



What makes a good poster?

- Attracts attention
- Is simple & concise-Don't try to include too many ideas
- Uses colors & white space effectively
- Text is large enough to be easily read
- Don't use all words or all illustrations
- · Research the theme topic & brainstorm ideas

Judging will be based on conservation message (50%) visual effectiveness (30%) originality (10%) universal appeal (10%).
