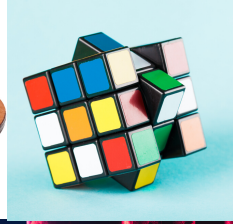

Finding Your Roots

Discover genealogy and create your family tree. We will show how you can find information via census files, old obituaries and more*. We will use the Family Heritage 4-H curriculum as a guide. Bring a laptop to this program.

Designing Roller Coasters

Understanding Birds

Learn about the adaptations that birds possess to make them successful in their environments. Participants will learn about bird anatomy, diet, ecological roles, calls and appearance.

Solving Rubik's Cube

Investigate the mystery & history of Rubik's Cube and the basic principles behind it. Then learn the steps to solving it. Participants will get a preliminary guide to solving this puzzle (they will not solve it at the workshop). Bring your own Cube to use.

Beading & Sequins

Learn how to bead & sequin for fashion! Youth will sew accents, using thread and a needle, to stylize a T-shirt. Choose to accent a shirt's design or logo (see above), or create your own design on a plain shirt. Bring a shirt; other supplies included.

Ages: 10-18 **Cost:** \$10 per youth

Working with Leather

Explore stamping & decorating leather! Participants will learn techniques and then design their own pre-punched leather key chain and set a rivet to attach the key ring.

Ages: 12-18 **Cost:** \$10 per youth

Acting & Theatre 101

Discover the world of theatre arts and acting! Learn about theatre lingo, the audition process, improvisation, and character development.

Time: March 26, 1:30-3 pm
Ages: 8-18 **Cost:** \$5 per youth
