# Kendall County Fair 4-H Livestock Auction Committee Scholarship 2020

#### **Scholarship Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior planning to enter college or trade school the following school year or a first year college or trade school student. The recipient may enter any college or trade school of his/her choice in any degree program.
- 2. Applicant must be a Kendall County 4-H member for a minimum of four (4) years.
- 3. Applicant must be enrolled in the dairy, beef, sheep, goats, chickens, rabbits, or swine project. Preference will be given to Kendall County 4-H members who have consistently and actively participated in the 4-H livestock projects.
- 4. Applicants may re-apply for the scholarship if they meet the eligibility requirements for the application year, but may receive this scholarship only once.
- 5. The scholarship does not have to be awarded annually, contingent on availability of qualified applicants and available funds.
- 6. Recipient of scholarship must maintain full time student status. If scholarship recipient does not maintain full time status, scholarship amount shall be refunded to the Kendall County Livestock Auction Committee.

#### **Scholarship Criteria:**

- 1. Livestock Experiences and Achievement 50%.
- 2. Other Community/School Activities/Awards 25%.
- 3. Essay question– 15%.
- 4. Letter of reference 10%.

## **Application Process:**

- 1. Applications are due by **June 15, 2020**. Return application to: Kendall County 4-H Livestock Auction Scholarship, 7775B Illinois Route 47, Yorkville, Illinois 60560.
- 2. The scholarship funds will be awarded by a selection committee composed of at least two (2) Kendall County Fair 4-H Livestock Auction committee members and two (2) members of the community.
- 3. The scholarship will be a minimum of \$500.
- 4. Scholarship winner will be notified by mail. The winner will be announced at the Kendall County Fair 4-H Livestock Auction. The scholarship money will be presented at the Kendall County 4-H Achievement Night, which is usually held in November, upon receipt of proof of enrollment.
