- 1. The recipient must be in college or trade school currently, or graduating high school senior planning to enter college or trade school the following school year.
- 2. The recipient must be a past or present, minimum 4 year member of Kendall County 4-H.
- 3. One personal reference is required (cannot be a relative or 4-H leader).
- 4. The scholarship will be awarded on a combined basis of need, merit, and 4-H work. Indicate special need on the application.
- 5. The recipient may enter any college or trade school of their choice in any degree program of their choice.
- 6. This scholarship may be given more than once. A previous recipient must submit the most recent transcript from their school.
- 7. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student after proof of enrollment.
- 8. Return application to: *Kendall County 4-H Foundation, 7775B Illinois Route 47, Yorkville, Illinois 60560. Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
- 9. The scholarship will be presented at the Kendall County 4-H Achievement Night, which is usually held in November.
- 10. The scholarship funds will be held by the Kendall County 4-H Foundation and awarded by a selection committee composed of representatives of the 4-H Foundation. Additional contributions to the fund will be accepted.
- 11. The scholarship does not have to be awarded annually.
- 12. Only available interest from the scholarship fund will be used and not the principle. The scholarship will be a minimum of \$500.00 and maximum of \$1000.00, if awarded.
- 13. If the recipient does not enter and complete one year of college or trade school after receiving the scholarship, the money will be returned to the Kendall County 4-H Foundation.
- 14. Applications are available at the Kendall County Extension office.
