## **Rules and Guidelines**

- 1. The recipient must be in college or trade school currently or may be a graduating high school senior to enter college or trade school the following school year.
- 2. The recipient must be a past or present Kendall County 4-H member.
- 3. The scholarship will be awarded on a combined basis of need, merit, and 4-H work. Indicate special need on the application.
- 4. The recipient may enter any college or trade school of their choice in any degree program of their choice.
- 5. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student after proof of enrollment.
- 6. Return application to: Kendall County 4-H Foundation, 7775B Illinois Route 47, Yorkville, IL 60560. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
- 7. The Scholarship will be presented at the Kendall County 4-H Achievement Night, which is usually held in November.
- 8. The scholarship funds will be held by the Kendall County 4-H Foundation and awarded by a selection committee composed of representatives of the Kendall County Extension Council and the 4-H Foundation with a minimum of one member from each. Additional contributions to the fund will be accepted.
- 9. The scholarship does not have to be awarded annually.
- 10. The scholarship will be a minimum of \$500 and maximum of \$1000, if awarded.
- 11. If the recipient does not enter and complete one year of college or trade school after receiving the scholarship, the money will be returned to the Kendall County 4-H Foundation.
- 12. Applications are available at the Kendall County Extension office and at the guidance counselors' office in the Kendall County high schools.
- 13. Youth may only receive award one time only.
- 14. Please provide at least one personal reference letter from an adult (other than a relative)
