

PERCY & EVELYN REBHORN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established "In Honor of 4-H Leaders Past, Present and Future".

Rules and Guidelines

For questions about this scholarship and/or the application call the Kendall County Extension Office at 630/553-5823. *Please return to the Extension Office by September 15.*

1. The recipient must be in college or trade school currently, or a graduating high school senior planning to enter college or trade school the following school year.
2. The recipient must be past or present Kendall County 4-H member.
3. The applicant must have completed at least one agricultural 4-H project (crops, animals, or horticulture).
4. The scholarship will be awarded on a combined basis of need, merit, and 4-H work. Indicate special need on the application.
5. The recipient may enter any college or trade school of their choice in any degree program of their choice.
6. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student after proof of enrollment.
7. Return application to: *Kendall County 4-H Foundation, 7775B Illinois Route 47, Yorkville, Illinois 60560. Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
8. The scholarship will be presented at the Kendall County 4-H Achievement Night, which is usually held in November.
9. The scholarship funds will be held by the Kendall County 4-H Foundation and awarded by a selection committee composed of representatives of the Kendall County Extension Council and the 4-H Foundation, with a minimum of one member from each. Additional contributions to the fund will be accepted.
10. The scholarship does not have to be awarded annually.
11. Only the available interest from the scholarship fund will be used and not the principle. The scholarship will be a minimum of \$100.00 and maximum of \$250.00, if awarded.
12. If the recipient does not enter and complete one year of college or trade school after receiving the scholarship, the money will be returned to the Kendall County 4-H Foundation.
13. Applications are available at the Kendall County Extension office and at the guidance counselor's offices in the Kendall County high schools.
