

## JOHANNA VANDERMEER MEMORIAL HOME ECONOMICS SCHOLARSHIP

### Rules and Guidelines

For questions about this scholarship and/or the application call the Kendall County Extension Office at 630/553-5823. *Please return to the Extension Office by September 15.*

1. The recipient must be a current college student, or a graduating high school senior planning to enter college the following school year to pursue a degree in a home economics related field. See attached list for home economics related fields.
2. The scholarship will be awarded on a combined basis of need and merit, based on written application. Preference will be given to persons active in the Kendall County 4-H program.
3. The recipient may enter any college of their choice.
4. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student.
5. **Students may receive scholarship more than once.**
6. Return application to: *Kendall County 4-H Foundation, 7775B Illinois Route 47, Yorkville, Illinois 60560. Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
7. The scholarship will be presented at the Kendall County 4-H Achievement Night, Kendall County HCE Annual Meeting, or where deemed appropriate. It will be presented by December 1.
8. The scholarship funds will be held by the Kendall County 4-H Foundation and awarded by a selection committee composed of representatives of the Kendall County Extension Council, Kendall County 4-H Foundation, and Kendall County HCE Board, with a minimum of one member from each. Additional contributions to the fund will be accepted.
9. The scholarship does not have to be awarded annually, contingent on availability of qualified applicants and available funds.
10. Only the available annual interest from the scholarship fund will be used and not the principle. The scholarship will be a minimum of \$100.00, if awarded.
11. If the recipient does not enter an appropriate degree program and complete one year of college during the year after receiving the scholarship, the money will be returned to the Kendall County 4-H Foundation.
12. Applications are available at the Kendall County Extension office and at the guidance counselor's offices in the Kendall County high schools.
