Tuesday, June 15 th	5 pm to 8 pm
Thursday, June 17 th	5 pm to 8 pm
Saturday, June 19 th	10 am to 3 pm

NEW – Beef exhibitors, please put a copy of your registration papers with your entry.

All livestock/horses will need to have health certificates/coggins test paper. Turn in your paperwork to your superintendent or at the office.
