Eligibility:

1. A High School Senior or College Freshman who is planning to continue their education at a University or Junior College.
2. Field of Study must be Agricultural, Business, Education or General Studies.
Agricultural related studies will receive first preference, then Business, then Education with General Studies last.
3. A 4-H member of a Lawrence County 4-H Club within the previous two (2) years.
4. Enrolled in a Livestock Project (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Dairy, Horse, Rabbits, Goats, and Poultry) within the previous two (2) years.
5. Exhibited an animal at the 4-H Show previous two (2) years.
