Eligibility:

- 1. A High School Senior or College Freshman who is planning to continue their education at a University or Junior College.
- 2. Field of Study must be Agricultural, Business, Education or General Studies. Agricultural related studies will receive first preference, then Business, then Education with General Studies last.
- 3. A 4-H member of a Lawrence County 4-H Club within the previous two (2) years.
- 4. Enrolled in a Livestock Project (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Dairy, Horse, Rabbits, Goats, and Poultry) within the previous two (2) years.
- 5. Exhibited an animal at the 4-H Show previous two (2) years.
