

2020-2021 4-H YEAR

All Livingston County 4-H members must attend at least three club meetings or activities and give a talk or demonstration at the club level to be considered an active member of Livingston County 4-H. These requirements must be met between September 1 and June 15 of the current 4-H year.

In addition to the above meeting requirements, the following enrollment deadlines must be met by all 4-H members of Unit 12 Livingston, McLean and Woodford Counties. All returning 4-H members must be enrolled in at least one 4-H project and have paid their \$20 4-H program fee to the Extension office to be considered active, covered by University Insurance and receive future communications from the Extension office. Members will have until April 15 of the current 4-H year to add or drop 4-H projects. All new 4-H members must be enrolled in all of their 4-H projects and pay their 4-H program fee to the Extension office by April 15 of the current 4-H year in order to show in the local 4-H Show.

Only active Livingston County 4-H members will be allowed to participate for premiums in the Livingston County 4-H Show, receive free admission to the Livingston County Ag Fair and be eligible to sell livestock at the Livingston County Ag Fair Sale.
