4-H Tractor Driving Contest held at Macoupin County Fairgrounds

Macoupin County 4-H members had the opportunity to display their tractor driving skills at the 4-H Tractor Operator's Contest held on Thursday, June 13 at the Macoupin County Fairgrounds.

The tractor driving contest consists of a written knowledge test about tractor safety and maintenance, parts identification test, safety inspection, and a driven course requiring the 4-H member to use their tractor operating skills.

The contest consists of a junior division, which was 10-14 years old, and a senior division, which is 15 and older. Winning the Top Junior Operator this year was Peter Jarden of Bunker Hill. Top Senior Operator was awarded to Luke Wolff of Shipman. Reserve Senior Operator was Aaron Mayfield of Livingston and Reserve Junior Operator was Ethan Cloninger of Plainview. Other participants earning blue ribbons were Carter Joiner and Alex Behme of Carlinville.
