- learn about grant money for projects




Carlinville Primary Teacher Grant Project

Specialty crops: Learn about a diverse farming operation including specialty crops such as strawberries, asparagus, blackberries, blueberries, and peaches: homegrown products including canned and baked goods; and traditional crops of corn, soybeans, and wheat.



Wholesale flower supplier: located in St. Louis on "Flower Row", you will see flowers and plants that are shipped in from around the world.



- **Plant science**: learn about state-of-the-art research and breeding to deliver improved seed performance and plant protection using less land, water and energy.
- Hands-on activities: Explore hands-on agricultural activities and receive resources to use in the classrooms.
