- How has 4-H helped you feel better about yourself?
- > 8-10 year olds should write at least one paragraph addressing at least 3 of the above questions.
- 11-14 year olds should write two or more paragraphs with more details answering at least 4-5 of the above questions.
- > 15-19 year olds should write at least one page answering at least 6-8 of the above questions.

Stories may be handwritten or typed. If typing, please use a 12 pt font. If writing, please write legibly. Be sure to type your name on the separate page and attach it to this application. **Please use additional sheets if necessary.**
