### 4-H Enrollment & **Club Meeting Attendance**

Time is ticking and a deadline is quickly approaching! Don't wait, take care of this today!



4-H members should enroll in general projects by the May 1, 2022 deadline in order to ensure eligibility to exhibit in those project areas at the 2022 4-H Show in July. (Livestock project enrollment deadline was January 4, 2022 for beef, swine, goats and sheep projects.)

Anyone can join 4-H after the May 1, 2022 deadline, however they will not be eligible to exhibit at the 2022 4-H show.

Please take time to double check the projects you have enrolled in! May 1 is also the deadline to add or drop any projects in 4-H online. Call the Extension office if you have questions, or need project manuals.

4-H members and leaders, as well as shooting sports coordinators, instructors, and assistants, should all take a few minutes to re-enroll in 4-H as a member or volunteer if you haven't already done so.

Go to https://v2.4honline.com to update your profile and complete your enrollment for the year. Getting your enrollment completed will ensure you will remain on the 4-H mailing list to receive 4-H news, club, and project information.

**Meeting attendance** ... As always, 4-H members are required to be actively involved in club meetings and events. Meeting attendance is required to be eligible to exhibit at the county 4-H Show. Club leaders and secretaries should be tracking attendance at each meeting. The Extension office will check member attendance records before allowing 4-H Show entries. Member attendance and participation helps to build strong communication and leadership skills, as well as making club meetings more fun!

### **Mason County 4-H Shooting Sports Club News**

**Enroll now!** Anyone interested in 4-H Shooting Sports projects (Shotgun, Air Rifle, Rifle, Rifle, Archery, or Hunting & Wildlife) should enroll in the Mason County 4-H Shooting Sports Club. This club teaches firearm safety and skills, awareness of related career opportunities, and helps youth develop leadership abilities. You can enroll at <a href="https://v2.4honline.com">https://v2.4honline.com</a>. Get enrolled now so you will receive any club news and updates!

Mark your calendar! The club's first meeting will be Sunday, April 10, 2022 at 2p.m. at the Mason County Extension office lower level. This meeting will be a mandatory informational and safety meeting for members and their parents. Completion of online enrollment, medical and liability forms, and payment of all fees will be required before youth are allowed to participate in club events. The \$20 annual 4-H enrollment fee can be paid online at time of enrollment or by check, payable to U of I. Shooting sports discipline fees, which cover costs of ammunition & targets, must be paid directly to the club with cash or check at the first meeting. Discipline fees are as follows: \$10 each-shotgun, .22 rifle, .22 pistol; \$5 each- air rifle, air pistol, archery, hunting & wildlife. Discipline fees will cover 6-8 shooting sports weekly sessions. Meetings are planned for Sunday afternoons from 2-4 p.m. April 24, May 1, 15, 22, 29. Back-up dates June 5 &12.

Club meetings will take place at the 4-H shooting sports range in rural Havana. Shooting sports equipment, including firearms, ammunition, and safety gear, is provided for all youth participants. Youth who own their own equipment are welcome to bring it for inspection by an instructor, and must receive permission to use it on the 4-H range.

**Adult Volunteers Needed!** The Mason County 4-H Shooting Sports Club is in need of adult volunteers who are willing to assist or instruct youth in the shooting sports disciplines. A volunteer application, and background checks must be completed for all 4-H volunteers. To receive Adult Volunteer Shooting Sports Instructor Certification, you must attend one of the three scheduled trainings being offered in the state (see article on page 5 in this newsletter). Please contact Joli Pierson at the Extension office if you are interested in becoming a 4-H volunteer with this club.
