4-H Enrollment & Club Meeting Attendance

Time is ticking and a deadline is quickly approaching! Don't wait, take care of this today! 4-H members should enroll in general projects by the May 1, 2023 deadline in order to ensure eligibility to exhibit in those project areas at the 2023 4-H Show in July. Livestock project enrollment deadline was January 3, 2023 for beef, swine, goats and sheep projects. Anyone can join 4-H after the May 1, 2023 deadline, however they will not be eligible to exhibit at the 2023 4-H Show.

Please take time to double check the projects you have selected! This is the time to add or drop any projects from your enrollment. Call the Extension office if you have questions about your projects.

4-H members and leaders, as well as shooting sports coordinators, instructors, and assistants, should all take a few minutes to re-enroll in 4-H as a member or volunteer if you haven't already done so. Go to the NEW enrollment website: <u>https://4h.zsuite.org</u> to update your profile and complete your enrollment for the year. Getting your enrollment completed will ensure continuation on the 4-H mailing list to receive 4-H news, club, and project information.

Meeting attendance ... As always, 4-H members are required to be actively involved in club meetings and events. Meeting attendance is required to be eligible to exhibit at the county 4-H Show. Club leaders and secretaries should be tracking attendance at each meeting. The Extension office will check member attendance records before allowing 4-H Show entries. Member attendance and participation helps to build strong communication and leadership skills, as well as making club meetings more fun!

Mason County 4-H Shooting Sports Club, begins soon!

If you haven't enrolled in this fun club, now is the time to do so! Go to https://4h.zsuite.org and enroll in the Mason County 4-H Shooting Sports Club. The club offers air rifle, rifle, shotgun, pistol, and archery disciplines. Youth ages 8-18 (8 yrs. old by Sept. 1, 2022) are eligible for archery, air rifle, and air pistol disciplines. Youth age 10-18 years (10 yrs. old by Sept. 1, 2022) are eligible for shotgun, .22 rifle, and .22 pistol discipline. The club's first meeting will be Sunday, April 16, 2023 at 2p.m. at the Mason County Extension office lower level. This meeting will be a mandatory informational and safety meeting for members and their parents. Completion of online enrollment, medical and liability forms, and payment of all fees will be required before youth are allowed to participate in club events. The \$20 annual 4-H enrollment fee can be paid online at time of enrollment or by check, payable to U of I. Shooting sports discipline fees, which cover costs of ammunition & targets, must be paid directly to the club with cash or check at the first meeting. Discipline fees are as follows: \$10 each- shotgun, .22 rifle, .22 pistol; \$5 each- air rifle, air pistol, and archery. Discipline fees will cover 6-8 shooting sports weekly sessions. Meetings are planned for Sunday afternoons from 2-4 p.m. April 16, 23, 30, May 7, 21, June 4 &11.

Club meetings will take place at the 4-H shooting sports range in rural Havana. Shooting sports equipment, including firearms, ammunition, and safety gear, is provided for all youth participants. Youth who own their own equipment are welcome to bring it for inspection by an instructor, and must receive permission to use it on the 4-H range.

Adult Volunteers Needed! The Mason County 4-H Shooting Sports Club is in need of adult volunteers who are willing to assist or instruct youth in the shooting sports disciplines. Please contact Joli Pierson at the Extension office if you are interested in becoming a 4-H volunteer with this club.


Participants attend academy sessions led by university professors and enjoy a variety of engaging activities that provide a taste of just how cool college life can be. Stay tuned for registration this spring!


