Owen, along with two members from Fulton County and one from Hancock County, represented Illinois in the shotgun discipline where they competed in skeet, trap, and sporting clay competitions. Owen competed in the Illinois State Shooting Sports competition in September of 2021, ranking in the top five, to qualify him for the National Championships.

Owen and the Illinois team shot with 120 other top shooters from all around the nation, battling strong winds and extreme heat during the competition week.
