#### Clark County 4-H Leaders Meeting May 4, 2021 Clark County Extension Office

The Treasurer's Report was given and reflected no changes from the March 1, 2021 report; the report was approved as read with an ending balance of \$5,0405.27.

### **Old Business**

A Decorating Committee was assembled to organize decoration of the Arts Hall and livestock areas. Basic theme ideas of red carpet, celebrities, and the Oscars were generally discussed. The Committee includes Sara Hosfield, Veronica Cornejo, and Teresa Winneett.

Shooting Sports will not be holding an exhibition this year. Youth may still participate with poster projects if their meeting attendance requirement is met.

There will be no 4-H related food and drink stands, and 4-H will have no involvement with arrangements for staying on the fairgrounds – families interested in camping should contact the Martinsville Fair Board for information.

Ag Ed, owners of the Extension Office building, are changing the locks on the meeting room area. Jane Williams will make direct contact with Leaders who use the building to arrange turning in old lock keys and getting new lock keys.

4-H Record deadlines were discussed, as were deadlines for award applications, Secretary's Books, and Treasurer's books.
