### **COVID-19 UPDATE**

After consideration and approval by Extension administration, on July 6, Illinois Extension Master Gardeners will have the option to start volunteering at their local volunteer project sites, with the requirement that no more than 10 people be present and established safety guidelines are followed.

Before returning to volunteering, you must confirm with your Master Gardener Coordinator, Erin Garrett, that the activities you plan to participate in have been approved. Be prepared to give details about location, time, and contacts. Pre-approval is required.

Please note that all Extension sponsored events and public programs continue to be postponed or hosted virtually until July 31. Master Gardener volunteers have received special permission to return to volunteering and it applies only to working solo or in very small groups with fellow volunteers at approved sites. Volunteering with the general public and any other audience is not permitted at this time.

REMEMBER, because of limited volunteer opportunities available, the 30-hour volunteer requirement to maintain your active status for 2020 has been waived.

This is an evolving situation, so these guidelines are subject to change, based on guidance from the University of Illinois and guidelines provided by the Centers for Disease Control. We appreciate the commitment of our volunteers to these volunteer programs, as well as your patience and commitment to safety as we navigate these times.
